Dear Mr. Perez and Commissioners,

I would like to share my concerns about the storage facility being proposed to be built next to Perris Valley Airport.

As a skydiver and private pilot, I have personally enjoyed using this airport since 2005. I have witnessed the tremendous impact the airport and Perris Valley Skydiving have on the local economy with its many visitors who frequent from around the world. I'm concerned the airport may be forced to close due to safety concerns surrounding the turbulence those buildings would cause for both parachutes and aircraft if they are built.

As a skydiver, turbulence from the rotors off a building at another dropzone once collapsed half of my canopy when I was 50' off the ground, and it's only a matter of luck it re-inflated in time to not have life-threatening consequences. One of my close friends is a double-amputee as a result of his canopy collapsing at the same height. The effects of wind coming across buildings near runways and landing areas are a serious enough concern for aviators that this added risk would be reason for me to choose another airport to travel to if more buildings go up adjacent to the Perris Valley Airport.

Please consider these issues as you prepare your report.
