Mr. Perez, Commissioners and Staff, Regarding Perris Airport Logistics Center PLN 22-05046, DPR 22-00005. CUP 23-05107.

This is Patrick Conatser from Perris Valley Airport, again. Once again, I would like to thank you all for the opportunity to add information for review in the EIR.

A couple items to be looked at in the EIR:

Item one being public safety for the parachuting/skydiving public. The project as you all know by now is in arguably the world's parachute largest drop zone. This project area is an area that we leased for over 40 years for landing area and runway. This project and the height of the proposed buildings are of real safety concern to us. The building being so large that more than likely wayward parachutists will unfortunately land on it. There needs to be a quick way to access the top of the buildings. Winds do change and things that are not planned to happen do and with those in that location there is ample opportunity. (Smooth roof, rapid egress) This should be fully addressed in the EIR.

Item two, regarding the applicants plan and parcel map NO. 3841. First the map is inaccurate and depicts the runway stopping well short of the runway's full length. Second it proposes moving the runway its centerline and additionally changing the property lines. We have no interest in doing either and is probably not even possible with the runway as it is FAA/ Caltrans aeronautic approved in its current historic location. This should be fully investigated in the EIR.

Thank you again for allowing public comment regarding the proposed project.
