

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 6724**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF  
RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
NAMING THE MORGAN PARK SYNTHETIC  
SOCCER FIELD THE PEDRO “PETE”  
MAGAÑA FIELD**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Perris recognizes the importance of honoring individuals who have made significant contributions to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Pete Magaña has dedicated more than 25 years of volunteer service with American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO) in Perris, positively impacting the lives of countless youth and families through his leadership, mentorship, and unwavering support of recreational soccer programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Recreation Committee reviewed and supported the proposal on August 20, 2025, recommending that the synthetic soccer field at Morgan Park be named in honor of Mr. Magaña to acknowledge his dedication and commitment to youth sports and the Perris community; and

**WHEREAS**, naming the Morgan Park synthetic soccer field in honor of Mr. Magaña is a fitting and lasting tribute that reflects the City’s values of service, volunteerism, and community pride;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Recitals Incorporated. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.** Naming of Field. The City Council hereby agrees to name the Morgan Park Synthetic Soccer Field, The Pedro “Pete” Magaña Field.

**Section 3.** CEQA. Pursuant to Section 15378 (b)(5) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, the adoption of this Resolution is not a project because it is an administrative activity of a government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment and even if it were a project, under Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines, it would be exempt because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

**Section 4.** Severability. If any subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Resolution or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that

any one or more subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase be declared unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable.

**Section 5.** Certification. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Resolution.

**Section 6.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
