

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 6728**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2025 EMERGENCY OPERATIONS BASE PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Perris desires to remain prepared and organized for the protection of persons and property in the event of a disaster or extreme peril caused by conditions such as air pollution, fire, flood, storm, epidemic, riot, earthquake, or other emergencies, including those resulting from war or imminent threat of war; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions created by such events are likely to be beyond the control of the services, regular personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City, and may require the combined efforts of other political jurisdictions to effectively respond; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Perris originally adopted its Emergency Operations Plan in 2006 and last updated it in 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Perris Emergency Management staff, in coordination with the Riverside County Emergency Management Department and the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, has revised and updated the Emergency Operations Plan to reflect current standards, best practices, and the specific needs of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City to adopt this updated Emergency Operations Plan to guide coordinated response and recovery operations;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Recitals Incorporated. The above-stated recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.** Adoption of Emergency Operations Plan. The City Council hereby approves and adopts the 2025 Emergency Operations Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as Exhibit "A," as the official Emergency Operations Plan of the City of Perris.

**Section 3.** Supersession of Prior Plans. The City Council declares that the 2025 Emergency Operations Plan supersedes and replaces all prior plans, including the 2006 original plan and the 2014 update.

**Section 4.** Severability. The City Council declares that, should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining

provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences or words of this Resolution as hereby adopted shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 5. Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
