

ORDINANCE NO. 1244

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.16.010 REGARDING COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Perris Municipal Code Section 2.16.010 codifies the compensation rate for city council members; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Sections 36516 and 36516.5 authorize the City to change the compensation of a city councilmember in accordance with a statutory formula; provided, however, that any change shall not become effective until one or more councilmembers commences a new term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adjust the compensation of city council members in accordance with the Government Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The foregoing Recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Amendment to Section 2.16.010 of the Perris Municipal Code. Section 2.16.010 (Councilmember -- Salary) of the Perris Municipal Code is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety to read as follows:

"Section 2.16.010 Councilmember -- Salary

Each member of the city council shall receive a salary of eight hundred ninety dollars per month."

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption. The new compensation for city councilmembers shall be effective as of December 1, 2008.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portions thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more

sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify as to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be posted at the designated locations in the City of Perris.
