

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4662

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR FUNDING UNDER THE HOUSING-RELATED PARKS PROGRAM; AND IF SELECTED, THE EXECUTION OF A STANDARD AGREEMENT, ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND OF ANY RELATED DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HOME HOUSING-RELATED PARKS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The California Department of Housing and Community Development (the “Department”) is authorized to allocate Housing-Related Parks Program (“HRP”) funds made available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”). Housing-Related Parks Program funds are to be used for the purposes set forth in Assembly Bill No 2494 (Caballero), Chapter 641, Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, On October 2, 2013 the Department issued a 2013 Notice of Funding Availability (“NOFA”) announcing the availability of funds under the Housing-Related Parks (HRP) program; and

WHEREAS, In response to the 2013 NOFA, the City of Perris a public body, corporate and political (the “Applicant”), wishes to submit the 2013 Designated Program Year Application Package released by the Department for the HRP Program; and

WHEREAS, The Department is authorized to approve funding allocations for the HRP Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, Program Guidelines, Application Package, and Standard Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Perris, as follows:

Section 1. Authorization to submit an application to the Department to participate in the HRP program for an activity and/or program to be located within the City of Perris limits is approved.

Section 2. If the application for funding is approved for the 2013 Designated Program year, such authorization includes direction to enter into, execute and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement), and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to secure the HRP Program Grant from the Department, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the “HRP Grant Documents”).

Section 3. Applicant shall be subject to the terms and conditions as specified in the Standard Agreement. Funds are to be used for allowable capital asset project expenditures to be identified in Exhibit A of the Standard Agreement. The application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application are enforceable through the Standard Agreement. Applicant hereby agrees to use the funds for eligible capital asset(s) in the manner presented in the application as approved by the Department and in accordance with the NOFA and Program Guidelines and Application Package.

Section 4. That the City Manager or his designee(s) is/are to execute, in the name of the applicant, the HRP Program Application Package and the HRP Grant Documents as required by the Department for participation in the HRP Program.

Section 5. The above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 6. The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
